Legal Assistance

If you need a legal consultation for a variety of issues such as Bankruptcy, Elder Law, Family Law, Housing, Utility issues, Public Benefits, and many other issues there is help available. You can schedule a 30 minute free consultation through Legal Aid of Southeastern Pennsylvania.
