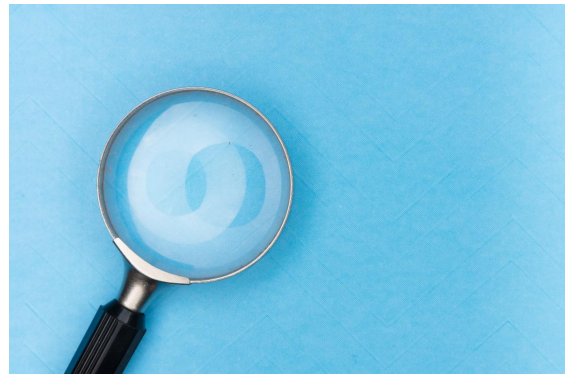
First Delco Gives Day a success!

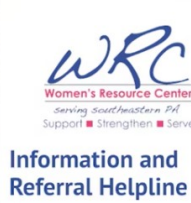
